Whereas, Thomas A. Edison
of Boston - in the county of Suffolk
and State of Mass, has invented the improved
"Magnetograph"

for which
he has made application for Letters Patent of the United States, and
I am about to make assigned to himself E. B. Welch and George L. Audus.

And Whereas, S. S. Laws of the City, County
and State of New York

has agreed to purchase from me all the right, title, and interest which I
have or may have in and to the said invention in consequence of the grant of Letters
Patent of the United States therefor, and has paid to me the said
George L. Audus

the sum of One Dollar -
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

Now this Indenture Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the said sum
to me paid, I have assigned and transferred, and do hereby assign and
transfer to the said S. S. Laws, all my right title and interest
(One third of the) in the full and exclusive
right to the said invention, and to the Letters Patent of the United States which may
be granted therefor. And I hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of
Patents to issue the said Letters Patent to the said S. S. Laws and
E. B. Welch and Thos. A. Edison
as the assignees of the whole right and title thereto, for their own use and behoof,
and for the use and behoof of their assigns and legal representatives, subject to
an agreement signed between said Edison Welch and myself -
and recorded at the Patent Office of the U.S.

Laws his representatives and assigns as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me if this assignment and sale had not been made.
