It is my privilege to transmit to you the following resolutions which were unanimously adopted at the annual meeting of the U. S. National Committee of the International Electrotechnical Commission:

RESOLVED that the U. S. National Committee of the International Electrotechnical Commission, at its meeting in New York on December 12, 1939, express and record its recognition of the sad loss it has suffered through the death of its Honorary President, Dr. Kennelly, as follows:

The members of the United States National Committee of the International Electrotechnical Commission, remembering with gratitude the services rendered both to the Committee and to the Commission by the late Doctor Arthur Edwin Kennelly, as member of the Committee and as Honorary President of the Committee and of the Commission, in the cause of international agreement and standardization, recall his splendid attainments as a scientist, mathematician, teacher and engineer; the notable citations and high honors accorded him by distinguished organizations at home and abroad which were the most competent to appraise the value of his work; his high sense of honor, unblemished integrity, personal friendliness and unselfish devotion to the good causes for which he fought so hard and so effectively; **RECORD** their sense of the great loss which they have sustained in his passing.
