DR. S. S. WHEELER IN PARIS

His Plan for Employing Blind Soldiers in Electric Work Adopted.

PARIS, April 24.—French electrical works have arranged to employ men who have been blinded in the war to wind armatures, after the system of Schuyler Wheeler of New York.

It is also understood that the system will be introduced in England, for which purpose Mr. Wheeler will go to that country.

Dr. Schuyler Skaats Wheeler, who is head of the Crocker-Wheeler Company of Ampère, N. J., and had established in this country the Double Duty Finger Guild to teach blind persons to earn their living in the electrical manufacturing business, went to Paris several weeks ago to demonstrate his system at the invitation of Eugène Brieux, representing the Government.
