Dear Mr. Bering: -At the meeting of our Board of Directors held Nay 21, the following memorial minute to Dr. Carl Hering, who, as you know, was one of the past presidents of our Institute, was adopted: "In the death of Dr. Carl Bering, on May 10th, a distinguished member has been removed from the ranks of the A.I.E.E. pioneers. From eighteen eighty-eight, when he affiliated with the Institute, down through his years of faithful and able service as a committeeman, and as President in 1900 and 1901, Dr. Hering firmly stood for the maintenance of Institute ideals. It is with a sense of the great loss sustained that the Board of Directors hereby extends to his family and associates its sincere sympathy, and orders this minute spread upon
