Dear Madam:

As requested in your letter of February 3, I am enclosing herewith a recent photograph. The following is a brief biographical sketch and record of my professional career.

I was born at Knoxville, Tennessee, on January 9, 1893, attended the Knoxville public schools, and graduated from the University of Tennessee in 1915 with a degree of B.S. in Electrical Engineering.

On June 15, 1915 I entered the employ of the Aluminum Ore Company, East St. Louis, Illinois, as an Electrical Engineering apprentice. I remained with this company until 1921, serving successively as Electrical Test Engineer, Shop and Construction Foreman, Electrical Engineer and Assistant Power Superintendent.

In 1922 I joined the Aluminum Company of America Sales Organization and served as Sales Engineer in the Kansas City Sales Office until 1923.

In January 1923 I returned to the Aluminum Ore Company at East St. Louis, Illinois, for a year, on special engineering work.

In 1924 I joined the Tallassee Power Company at Alcoa, Tennessee, where I served in the capacity of Assistant District Electrical Superintendent through 1926.

In 1927 I became Superintendent of Power for the Aluminum Company of America, Alcoa, Tennessee, and hold that position at the present time.

My Institute activities have been as follows:

1919 - Joined the Institute as Associate Member.

1938-39 - Served as Vice-Chairman of the East Tennessee Section.

1939-40 - Served as Chairman of the East Tennessee Section.

1939- Present - Served on Institute Committee for Electrochemistry and Electrometallurgy.

1940-Present - Served as Director of the East Tennessee Section.

On January 15, 1941 I was appointed National Vice-Chairman of Membership Committee for the Southern District.

In the past several years I have contributed a number of articles to the technical press and various engineering societies.
