Dear Mr. Kant:

Mr. Harold Schwenk's proposed amendment for direct nomination and election of the members of the Administrative Committee by the members of the PGRFI appears to be an acceptable revision of Article VI of the By-Laws. In his Section 2 he refers to a Nominations Committee. However, he has omitted the wording in the present Section 1 which states that the Chairman shall appoint a Nominations Committee-- etc.

A change in wording of Section 5 will also have to be made. Wording to the effect that the notice to the members of the PGRFI that nominations are open shall contain the words "selection of nominees shall be guided by principles of efficiency, geographical distribution and organization distribution. The Administrative Committee in its elections shall also be guided by these same principles.
